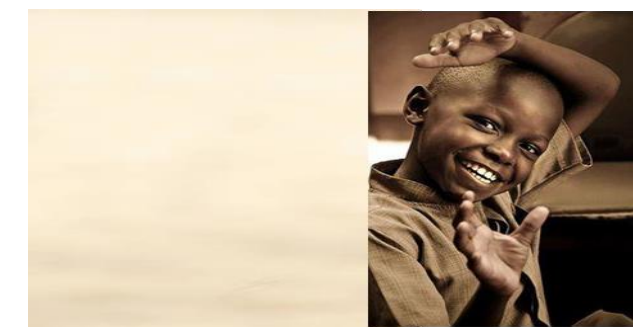

Healthcare is a fundamental right that every child deserves. Yet, sadly, mainly children in Ghana continue to face significant challenges in accessing adequate healthcare services.

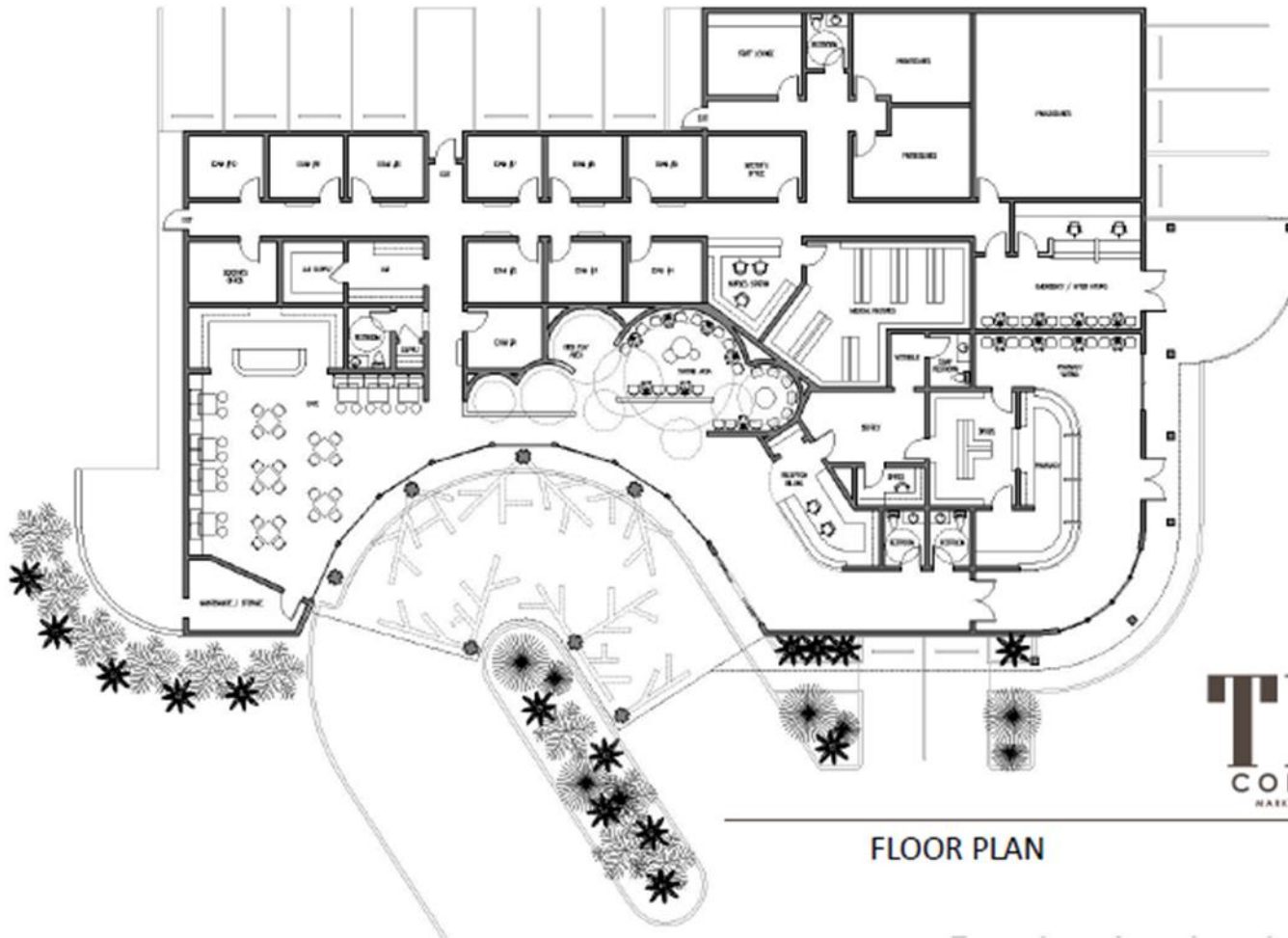
It is a well-documented fact that children in Ghana are confronted with many health challenges that are worsened by the high cost of healthcare and limited access to health resources.

Figures from the World Health Organization show that, out of every 1,000 live births in Ghana, 48 children have the probability of dying before reaching age 5.

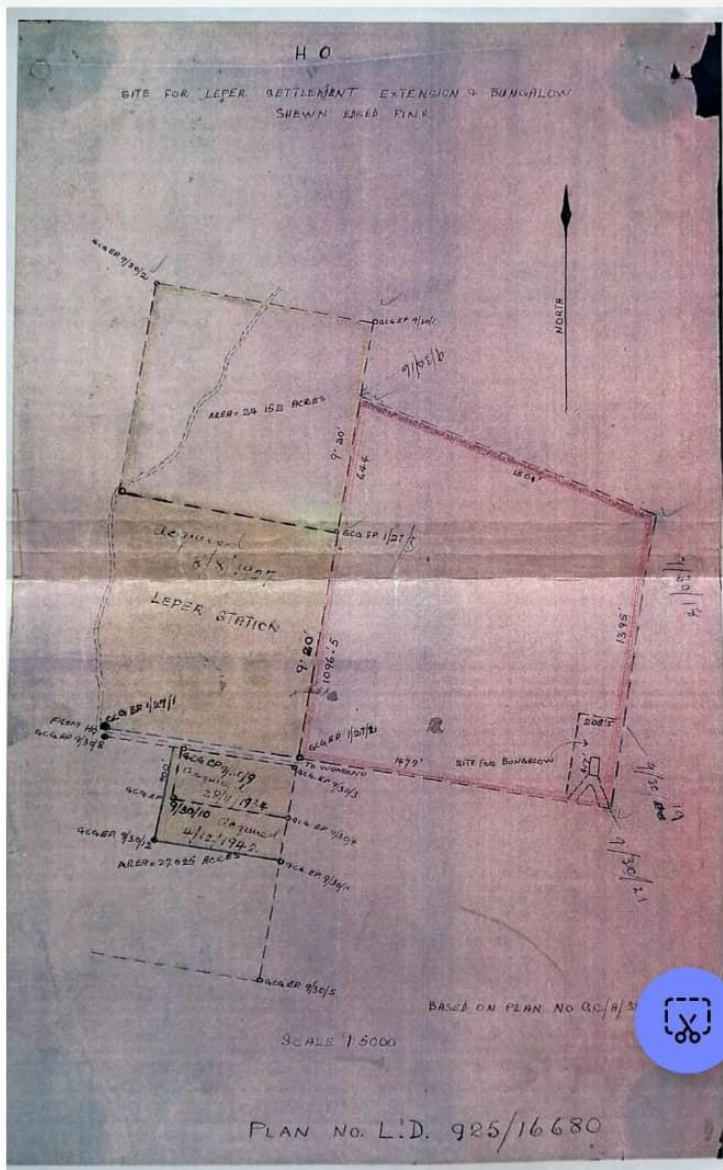
The Journey and Outcomes To Date

- Out of these concerts, we earned the support of the chiefs in the various localities and were given some pieces of land in these regions to construct the paediatric clinics on.
 1. An anonymous person donated 2 plots of land at the Ashiyie community where we held the first Hoodtalk Concert.
 2. His Royal Majesty Yakubu Abdullah Naa of Savelugu (Tamale) has donated 4 acres.
 3. Togbe Afede XIV (Agbogbomefia of Asogli State, the President of Asogli traditional area) and the MCE Hon. Devine R. K Bosson (Ho) have allocated land
- In light of this, sod-cutting ceremonies will be held within the year to begin the construction of the clinics starting from the Greater Accra Region.

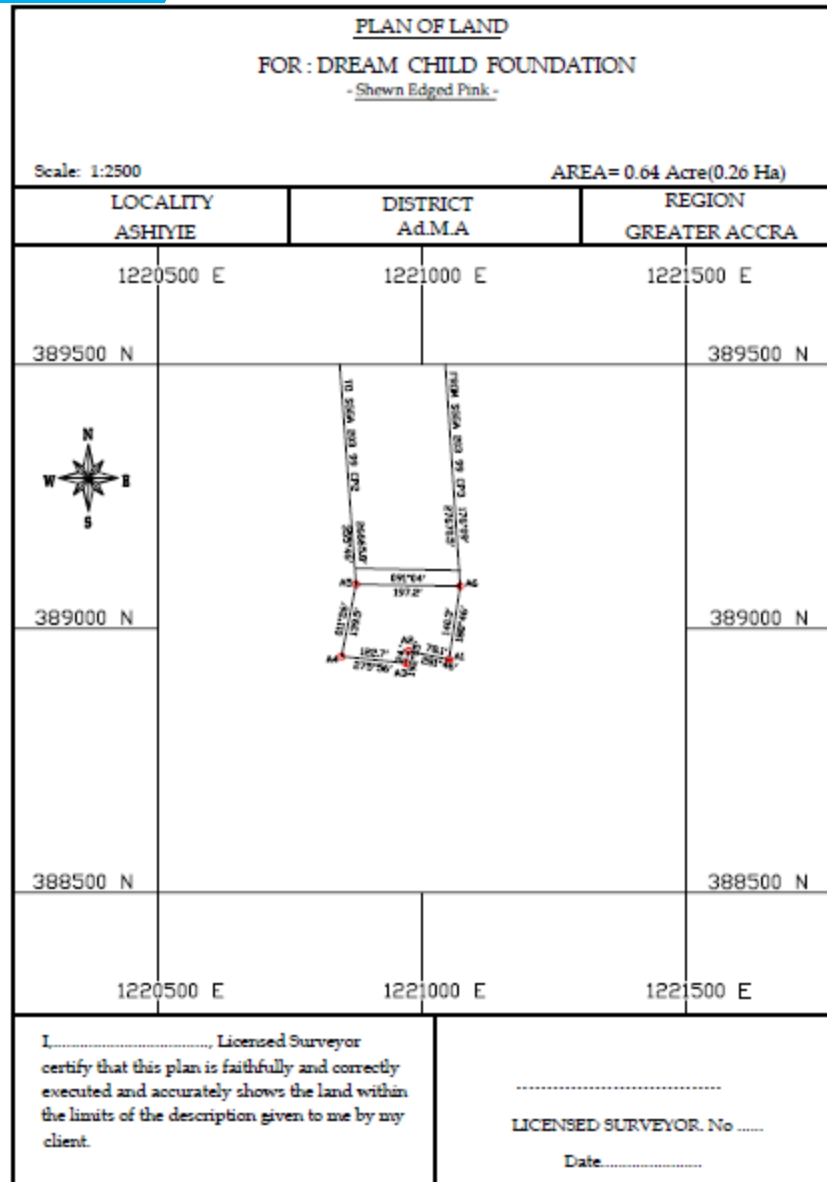
